 Insect pests can be a common occurrence in the veggie patch - eating leaves, severing stems and making your harvests less than desirable.

But damage can be reduced with a basic understanding of the bugs in question.

Have you had pest issues in your growing spaces? If so, observe the insects in your greens patch and take action against the ones doing the harm.

2. A constant supply of greens is possible throughout the summer - but will require you to sow lettuce seeds often.

Plant a small row every two weeks to insure you don't run out. Tuck them under taller growing veggies and take advantage of shady spots as the weather warms.
